Track, Investigate and Take Action with Gang Information

The Elite Prisons Security Threat Group Module is a gang intelligence solution that tracks organized groups, documents members and incidents and informs non-association rules. Integrated with housing, programs and movements, the STG Module gives records staff and unit officers the information they need to keep order, decrease gang activity and serve investigations legally. The STG Module is an option for Syscon Elite Prisons and Syscon Elite Jails.

Mission-Critical value

Minimizing risk – manage the information needed to investigate and suppress gangs and gang activity. Share information to improve public safety outside of prison walls.

Meeting obligations under budget – meet regulations on records age and definition, and inmate right to know and challenge gang association (such as US Federal 28 CFR 23) while providing quick retrieval of court-compliant digital records, thereby saving staff time and office space.

Managing populations – managing gang activity means more prisoners can be housed safely in the same space.

Solving Gang Challenges

Gang elusiveness – limit a gang's ability to operate covertly by gathering more data more often, as part of process.

Managing records – save staff time and office space by storing thousands of documents digitally, for quick retrieval and legal compliance.

Gang information on the job – provide a single source of accurate, real-time gang information to corrections officers as they make critical housing and movement decisions. Provide alerts if gang associations could cause problems.

Benefits for the Whole Team

Administrators & command staff – reduce spend on gang investigation and costs of gang violence. Investigate staff association with groups. Facilitate sharing of gang information with other corrections agencies and law enforcement agencies.

Security Threat Group investigators – improve depth of information. Find it faster with keyword search.

Corrections officers – see gang information when and where it's needed, as part of process and to inform decisions.

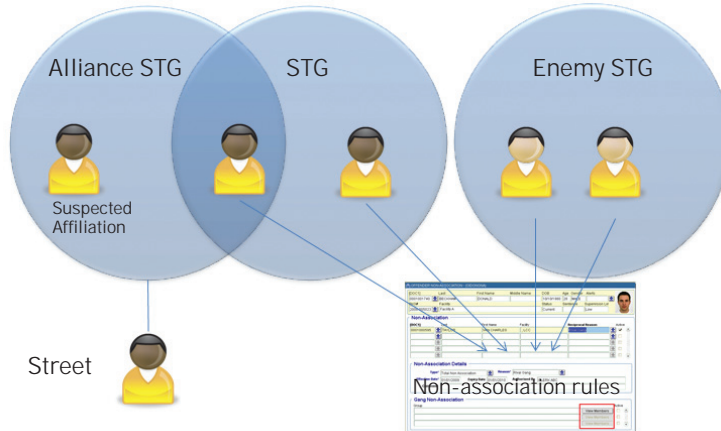

Functional Description

Recording STG information on offenders

- Record STG details for a specific offender
- Physical identifiers, tattoos and vocabulary
- Conduct offender assessments
- Record and validate aliases, contacts, associations

Recording information on STG

- Define new STG and validate/update STG details
- Add STG identifiers, monikers and images, known locations and ethnic composition
- Record case notes, documents, audio files and history on STG
- Record STG alliance and enemy groups

Investigating STG activity

- Search STG information using keywords
- View STG related incidents
- View possible STG related visits
- View STG membership, member details and locations
- Research case notes, documents, audio files and history on STG

Acting on STG information

- Present complete and current STG profile for staff on the job
- See STG assessments, affiliations and non-associations on admission, transfer and release
- Make housing, programs, movement and transport decisions with STG non-association information
- Receive alerts when decisions contradict non-association rules
